2017 saw a year of continued development. The Gatehouse continues to achieve much success on behalf survivors of Childhood Sexual Abuse (CSA).

The Partner's Program successfully completed its fourth year and introduced monthly partners meetings to further support partners/support persons of survivors in their healing journey. The visual arts support group has received extremely positive feedback and The Gatehouse is continuing partnership with Full Circle Art Therapy Centre.

The Gatehouse continues to engage in discussions with the City of Toronto Capital Division to have the foundation repairs completed and updates will be available to membership once official construction dates set.

The Gatehouse hosted the 2nd Annual Healing the Voice Within fundraiser that helped to raise over \$16,000 towards programs and services after expenses. We are looking forward to the 3rd Annual event taking place October 4, 2018.

The Healing Garden and the Labyrinth continue to provide spaces of healing, peace, and hope to the community. Thank you to Lloyd, Diane, Victor, Jay, Jenny, Jose, Walter and all others who have helped and continue to dedicate their time, energy and efforts to maintaining these beautiful spaces.

The Gatehouse, with the incredible support of our student team, continues to reach out to community organizations to inform about The Gatehouse programs, impart wisdom, and instill the importance of self-care. The continued development in the key areas of adult programs, as well as training in the areas of suicide prevention, peer facilitator training and transformational learning processes will remain a core competency of The Gatehouse. The Child Investigation Program continues to provide a safe place for children to disclose abuse and begin the healing process.

Over 100 participants took part in the 8th Annual Transforming Trauma Conference on June 1, 2018 sharing their collective wisdom to a highly receptive group looking for ways to transform trauma to triumph.

The Gatehouse continues to provide students from college and university the opportunity to complete field placement experience hours from various colleges and universities. Since 2012, 143 students have completed placement hours at The Gatehouse.

The Gatehouse Board Members, donors, volunteers, and staff at The Gatehouse are truly transforming lives.
