**Message from the chair**

2013 saw a year of continued growth. The Gatehouse has increased its service capacity with most evenings filled with support group meetings. Humber School of Social and Community Services will be funding two staff positions at The Gatehouse. All programming remains unchanged and the responsibility of The Gatehouse. Plans are to continue development in the key areas of adult programs Phase 2, developing a Partners program as well as the Young Adult Program.

A regular drop in program on Sundays will be introduced, 2pm-4pm for persons who have completed at least a Gatehouse phase 1 program.

In this past year we have facilitated four adult peer support group training sessions.

138 participants took part in the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Transforming Trauma Conference on April 28 & 29<sup>th</sup>. Local and international representatives from the UK and Bolivia were in attendance. Dr. Alok Mukherjee, Chair Police Services Board; Dr. Fred Mathews, Psychologist; and Mr. Tom Wilken, author of Rebuilding Your House of Self Respect shared

their collective wisdom to a highly receptive group looking for ways to transform trauma to triumph. The panel of international guest speakers included Mr. Parker Palmer & Ms. Brisa De Angulo, Gatehouse Founder co-founders A Breeze of Hope (Bolivia ; Mr. Peter Saunders, Founder of the National Association for People Abused in Childhood (NAPAC), UK; and Dr. Dorothee von Tippelskirch-Eissing, Psychoanalyst - Partners in Confronting Collective Atrocities (PCCA) from Germany.

We continue to provide students from college and university the opportunity to complete field placement experience hours.
